Printing & Supplies Needed



Printing Instructions

- ★ Print all pages on A4 cardstock paper using the "scale to fit" setting for best results.
- ★ Recommended paper: ASTROBRIGHT White Cardstock 65 lbs. for durability and vibrant colors.

Supplies Needed



Tape

Regular and double-sided for assembling the decorations.



Scissors or Paper Cutter

For precise trimming of the templates.



Hole Puncher

To prepare the Ramadan banner and gift tags.



Crayons, Markers, or Colored Pencils

For coloring and personalizing the templates



Ribbon or Twine

For hanging the banner and attaching the gift tags



Glue or Adhesive

For assembling the paper lanterns and straw banners



1-Prayer Rug Banner

- Print the design onto cardstock.
- Cut out the banner pieces according to their sizes.
- Punch a hole at number 1 and continue punching holes for the remaining numbers in order.
- Color the shapes as desired.
- Place number 4 (the foot) at the hole in number 5 using a ribbon or string to connect the punched holes.
- Continue threading the ribbon through the holes in numerical order.
- The final result will show a child standing on a prayer rug.

2-Paper Lantern and Shapes Banner

- Print the design on cardstock paper.
- Cut out the shapes along the designated borders.
- Color the lanterns according to the provided color guide.
- Use glue or adhesive tape to attach the lanterns to the wall.



3 - Your Goodness Last Stickers

- Print the design on sticker paper or cardstock.
- Color it as you see fit, following the example.
- Cut out the stickers and use them to decorate notebooks, walls, candy boxes or gifts.

4-Ramadan Crescent Sticker

- Print the design on sticker paper or cardstock.
- Cut out the crescent sticker.
- Color it.
- Hang it on the wall or on a notebook or candy box.

5-Ramadan Box-Part 01

- Print the design on cardstock paper.
- Cut out each box along the outer lines.
- Fold the edges along the dotted lines.
- Use glue or adhesive tape to assemble the box.
- Place a gift or sweets inside and seal it properly.
- Give it as a surprise gift to your loved ones.



6-Ramadan Box-Part 02

- Print the design on cardstock paper.
- Color the Gift Box
- Cut out each box along the outer lines.
- Fold the edges along the dotted lines.
- Use glue or adhesive tape to assemble the box.
- Place a gift or sweets inside and seal it properly.
- Give it as a surprise gift to your loved ones.

7 – Ramadan Mosque

- Print the design on cardstock paper.
- Color the mosque with your preferred colors before cutting.
- Use scissors to cut out the mosque along the solid outer lines.
- Cut along the small marks with the scissor to allow for assembly later.
- Fold the parts along the dotted lines to shape the structure properly.
- Use glue or adhesive tape to stick the sides together.
- Insert the cut tabs into the designated slots to secure the shape.
- Use the mosque as a table decoration or hang it on the wall.
- It can also be used as a small box to hold sweets or Ramadan gifts for children.






8-Ramadan Decorations


- Print the design on adhesive paper or cardstock.
- Use your preferred colors to color the shapes (crescent, stars, mosque).
- Cut out each sticker along the designated borders with scissors.
- Be precise while cutting to maintain the details.
- Stick the stickers on notebooks, walls, or gift boxes.
- Use them as decorations to beautify your home or children's room during Ramadan.
- You can also hang them using a string to create beautiful Ramadan garlands.

9 - Ramadan Mosque


- Print the design on thick paper or cardstock.
- Use your favorite colors to decorate the mosque.
- Cut out the outer shape of the mosque along the designated borders.
- Cut the small parts marked with to enable assembly later.
- Fold along the dotted lines to shape the mosque into a 3D structure.
- Use glue or tape to secure the parts together.
- Insert the cut-out tabs into the designated slots to ensure stability.
- Add creative touches such as sticking shiny stars and crescent shapes.
- Use a string or ribbon to hang it as a decorative piece.
- Use it as a Ramadan decoration for tables or walls.
- It can also be transformed into a small box for sweets or Ramadan gifts for children.






























