

Since its humble beginnings in 2014 with just \$200, Rahma Worldwide has grown into a global humanitarian organization, serving over 11 million beneficiaries with an annual budget exceeding \$20 million. This remarkable growth is a testament to the generosity of our donors, the dedication of our supporters, and the tireless work of our volunteers and field teams.

In 2023, we faced numerous challenges, responding swiftly to natural disasters such as the earthquakes in Syria, Turkey, and Morocco, the floods in Libya, and ongoing crises in Gaza and Sudan. We also launched impactful humanitarian campaigns, including our Winter Campaign, Qurbani, and Ramadan Campaign, each benefiting over one million people. Our ongoing efforts continue to include orphan sponsorship, well drilling, and support for vulnerable families.

We are proud to be the first American relief organization to conduct consecutive medical missions to Gaza, delivering critical medical supplies. With an investment exceeding \$4.5 million, we have completed 15 missions to date, involving over 328 doctors.

In addition to our work in Gaza, we expanded our impact across Africa and the Middle East by opening new offices in Kenya and the UAE. We also launched the first phase of our sustainable environmental initiative, "Plant Your Tree." This year, we made special visits to Yemen, Kenya, and other countries, and organized the "America Tour" with artist Mohammed Tarek to raise support for our projects in Gaza and around the world.

It has been a productive year, and we look forward to continuing our mission of doing even more good in the future.





Rahma Responds Urgently

We deliver rapid and essential relief to those impacted by natural disasters, conflicts, and humanitarian crises. Our mission is to swiftly meet the urgent needs of affected communities whether through food, medical aid, shelter, or other critical resources alleviating their suffering and helping them rebuild their lives with dignity.



Continuing Our Emergency Response

Since the beginning of the Gaza crisis, our teams on the ground have been among the first to respond, despite facing immense challenges and risks. Tragically, we lost three of our volunteers, who became martyrs in the cause of humanitarian work.

Additionally, our office, farm, and Rahma bakery suffered damages, yet our commitment to providing relief remains unwavering.

From day one, we utilized all our logistical resources and supplies stored in our warehouses to provide urgent relief to our people in Gaza. We established three field kitchens to address basic food needs, distributing 100,000 food baskets and 100,000 hot meals.

At a Cost of \$10 Million Benefiting 600,000

+1700 Aid Trucks to Gaza Through Egypt, Jordan, and the Palestinian territories, we delivered over 1,300 aid convoys with vital medical supplies and essential food items, becoming the first to reach northern Gaza. We also provided critical supplies, including essentials for women and children, ensuring comprehensive support to those in need.



15,000 Tents for the Displaced

Our teams mobilized to provide urgent assistance to displaced families who lost their homes by establishing 68 shelter centers and distributing 50,000 blankets, mattresses, and heaters.







Our Medical Missions

In partnership with local Ministry of Health, we supplied Gaza's healthcare sector with over \$3.5 million worth of medications, devices, and medical equipment. We also provided thousands of daily meals to medical staff, distributed 8,000 first aid kits, and delivered 100,000 liters of fuel to keep hospitals operational during the conflict.

Reducing Surgery Wait Times From Two Weeks to Two Days

Thanks to the coordinated efforts of our medical teams, we reduced the wait time for surgical interventions in Gaza from two weeks to just two days. These were more than statistics they were moments of life, filled with pain and hope, where countless lives were saved. Our mission continues until every patient in Gaza is reached, God willing.

The events have left deep scars on adults, so imagine the impact on children.

We couldn't leave them to face their fate alone. As the first American organization to act, we swiftly partnered to provide aid to the most vulnerable children, transferring them to the U.S.A for specialized care.

One such case is 4-year-old Omar, who tragically lost his entire family, many relatives, and his hand. He also suffered severe burns and amputations. Our teams worked tirelessly to arrange his transfer from Gaza to the U.S.A, where Shriners Hospital for Children in Philadelphia provided him with life-saving treatment. Thanks to the dedication of skilled doctors, Omar regained hope for a new life

Our Emergency Response to the Earthquake in Syria and Turkey

On February 6, 2023, a devastating earthquake struck Syria and Turkey, claiming thousands of civilian lives and causing massive destruction to infrastructure. Our teams quickly mobilized to provide emergency relief to those affected. Over the course of four months, we were able to assist more than 20,000 families.

Psychological Support Services

Our psychological support team provided 10,000 group and individual mental health consultations to those affected by the earthquake, with a special focus on children who experienced severe panic attacks and trauma due to the terrifying moments they endured.

Umm Maher

After her home was destroyed in the earthquake, Umm Maher (a mother of orphans) spent days and nights in the open. We rehabilitated her new, safe home and provided her with a monthly stipend to help care for her children and grandchildren.







Abu Rafiq

Abu Rafiq, from rural Idlib in northern Syria, experienced one of the most heartbreaking stories we witnessed during the earthquake. He lost nearly 30 members of his family and relatives beneath the rubble of his home. His only remaining family are his three daughters. We have provided lifetime support for Abu Rafiq and gifted him a 400-square-meter plot of land to rebuild his home, giving him a chance to start anew with hope.

Opening of Dr. Arsin Arslan Hospital Departments

After the main building of Dr. Arsin Arslan Hospital in Gaziantep, Turkey, was severely damaged, we swiftly intervened to restore the hospital's annex. We opened 25 specialized clinics, 15 operating rooms, and 3 intensive care units, providing essential care to over 300,000 patients annually. Today, the hospital serves more than 1.5 million beneficiaries each year, ensuring rapid and quality treatment for those impacted by the disaster.







We Were There Provide Urgent Support For

5,000 People in Morocco

On September 8, 2023, a 6.8 magnitude earthquake struck the Kingdom of Morocco, resulting in 2,497 deaths, 2,476 injuries, and displacing thousands of people. Despite the challenging terrain and difficulty reaching the remote mountainous areas, we provided urgent support to those affected. Our efforts included distributing food baskets, hygiene supplies, and winter aid, ensuring that those in need received essential supplies during these difficult times.



Reviving Healthcare in Gaza

At Kamal Adwan Hospital, we established and equipped the Emergency Response and Physical Therapy departments, while supporting new doctors administratively and financially. Although the Internal Medicine department's completion was delayed due to recent events, we refocused on strengthening emergency care across Gaza's hospitals. We secured international agreements to facilitate medical missions, bringing in 328 doctors and over \$4.5 million in essential medications and equipment. These efforts have saved lives and provided critical care to those most affected.



Hope Makers Center in Syria

The center provides physical therapy and care for the elderly and individuals with special needs, housing 20 elderly residents and serving around 50 beneficiaries daily.

Cataract Surgeries in Yemen

Our team performed 690 cataract surgeries at Mecca Hospital in Aden, including cataract removal and lens implantation using ultrasound technology.






Rahma Inspires Generations

Rahma's Mental Health Team

Our mental health team provides support and assistance to refugees and those affected by wars or natural disasters in Turkey and northern Syria. Over 88 psychologists and administrators have carried out numerous educational. psychological, and social activities at Rahma Worldwide's office in Gaziantep.

Psychological First Aid Training

One of the earliest initiatives launched by Rahma's Mental Health and Social Center in Turkey was a special training program to prepare psychological first responders (non-therapists). This initiative aimed at raising awareness of the importance of mental health and detecting disorders early, to provide necessary support before the situation worsens. More than 250 participants registered for the program.



A Lifeline of Hope

Despite the challenges and the impact on our team during the Syria-Turkey earthquake, Rahma's team quickly regained its ability to provide psychological and social services, including psychological first aid to the affected. In several Turkish states, including Gaziantep, Kilis, and Antakya, as well as northern Syria, we offered psychological support sessions to over 10,000 beneficiaries, both individually and in groups, for those affected by the earthquake.



Field Visits

Our administrative team prioritizes being on the ground, having conducted over 18 inspection visits aimed at understanding people's needs and providing urgent assistance directly within humanitarian and disaster-stricken areas.

Rahma's management in America had fruitful visits to Yemen, led by **Dr. Shadi Zaza** and **Mr. Ahmad Al-Halabi**, along with **Mr. Saleh Al-Haj**, Head of Fundraising, and **Mr. Abdulrahman Al-Attas**, Rahma's Yemen Office

Mr. Abdulrahman Al-Attas, Rahma's Yemen Office Director. The visits to Hadhramaut, Taiz, Aden, and Marib marked the launch of numerous sustainable development projects.



Vital Assistance and Projects

Basic essential supplies, including water, food, and baby formula, were distributed to displaced families. We handed out **500 school bags**, sponsored 500 orphans, and inaugurated an artesian well in Wadi Al-Qadi that serves **over 10,000 beneficiaries** struggling to access clean water. Additionally, we partnered with the Ministry of Education to print school textbooks.

38 Educational and Vocational Courses

Our team carried out capacity-building and sustainable development programs, including sewing, mobile phone repair, and computer skills courses. Mr. Ahmad Al-Halabi also led a training course on basic first aid for Rahma's Yemen team.

Thalaya School

Students at Thalaya School faced significant challenges, studying without desks in harsh conditions, which accelerated the completion of purchasing new land for the school at a **cost of \$145,000.**



Sustainable Projects in Gaza

We visited Gaza twice in 2023, prior to the events that unfolded later. Our tours were filled with achievements and sustainable projects. Our team worked tirelessly to arrange field visits post-2024 events to continue urgent relief efforts for our people in Gaza.

Project Cost

During our first visit in August 2023, we celebrated outstanding school and university students by providing them with financial aid. Additionally, we signed several agreements with officials from educational and health institutions, including a visit to the University of Gaza, where we laid the foundation for the Al-Izz and Karama Center. We also honored the American medical delegation, which performed 153 surgeries in 5 days, benefiting over 150 patients.

In October, just days before the major events, we conducted our second visit to Gaza, which included meetings with several medical and educational institutions such as the Al-Azhar Educational Institute, Turkish Friendship Hospital, and Al-Sahaba Medical Complex. We also met with officials from the Ministry of Health to discuss ways to enhance cooperation and support for our projects, aiming to improve healthcare quality in the region.

As Our Visit Continues in



Kenya

Our administrative team worked to expand Rahma Worldwide's presence in Africa, starting with the opening of our regional office in Kenya. We signed educational agreements to support local schools, visited orphan centers in Mombasa and Kilifi, and provided aid to them in their challenging circumstances. We also dug several wells across various regions in Kenya.



Turkey

Since the devastating earthquake hit Syria and Turkey in February 2023, Dr. Shadi Zaza led our administrative team to the affected areas to assess the damage and explore ways to rehabilitate and rebuild. The visit included the opening of new departments and clinics at Arsine Arslan Hospital in Gaziantep, participating as a key sponsor in the Syrian Graduates Conference, and honoring 1,150 trainees who completed digital skills training at our office.



Northern Syria

Our administrative team was on the ground from the very first moments of the February 2023 Svria-Turkey earthquake, supporting the affected in Northern Syria alongside the Syrian Civil Defense ("White Helmets"). We oversaw the preparations for Ramadan and Eid al-Adha projects and reviewed our humanitarian campaigns across multiple regions. We visited Dar Al-Salama for the elderly and people with special needs, as well as the Hope Makers Center for physical therapy and elder care in Azaz, rural Aleppo.



From Kenya, Here Comes Rahma

Our exceptional journey began from the heart of Africa, as we inaugurated the Rahma Worldwide office in Kenya. This strategic move was aimed at expanding our humanitarian efforts and establishing a hub for our projects across the African continent.



The Most Modern Slaughterhouse in Africa

In our commitment to contributing to food security in Kenya and across Africa, we opened Rahma's slaughterhouse. The facility is designed to regulate slaughtering operations according to the highest quality standards, ensuring the safety of both sacrificial animals and their meat. The most advanced techniques are employed, guaranteeing the provision of safe and fully processed meat to beneficiaries.



Plant Your Tree

As part of our vision for sustainable relief projects and our commitment to offering strategic environmental solutions, we launched the "Plant Your Tree" initiative. This project aims to combat the effects of climate change and enhance food security for local populations. By planting as many trees as possible, the project seeks to reduce temperatures, increase vegetation cover, and address global warming. The initiative directly benefits more than 500,000 people.







A Sustainable Environmental Project

Making a Difference

We embarked on our agricultural project with an inspiring slogan: **Plant Your Tree**, **Plant and Secure Your Future**. We believe that planting even a single tree can make a difference. A mature tree can absorb up to 26 kilograms of carbon dioxide annually and release enough oxygen to support two humans for a year.

Our project began in two regions of Kenya, but our ambition extends to Gaza, Lebanon, Yemen, and other regions around the world.



1,000,000 Trees

In the first phase of the project, we aim to plant 1,000,000 trees, benefiting over half a million people. This represents a new challenge we strive to meet with a spirit of generosity and solidarity.

As part of Rahma Worldwide's expansion plans in the Middle East, the United Arab Emirates has become a launching point for our humanitarian and development projects. These initiatives will transcend borders to reach the hearts of those in need across the Middle East, Africa, and South Asia. The UAE is recognized as a global leader in humanitarian efforts, providing \$3.45 billion in foreign aid in 2022 alone.

From Chicago, Here Comes Rahma

Chicago serves as a central hub for innovative projects aimed at welcoming refugees in North America. These initiatives provide support, guidance, and educational and recreational opportunities to meet the needs of refugees and help them achieve stability within the community. The city implements various programs designed to address the diverse needs of refugees and facilitate their integration into society.





The Media's Eye on Rahma






